Citizen's Advisory Committees for the Staff

Principal's Advisory Committee

The School Principal with the approval of the Superintendent may utilize interested parents and citizens in an advisory manner. Any committee, groups or focus group created by the school principal for advisory purposes shall be considered the Principal's advisory committee. The Principal shall give due consideration to the advice, suggestions and comments presented by participating parents or citizens but shall use their own best judgment in arriving at decisions.

Citizens, parents or volunteers contributing their services to the school shall receive guidance or training under the direction of the Principal in the exercise of roles, tasks and responsibilities.
