SCOTLAND BOARD OF EDUCATION Board Policy

Fire & Emergencies Services Department, Town Fire Marshall & Emergency Management Department

Members of the Scotland Volunteer Fire Department, the Town Fire Marshal and the Emergency Management Director play a vital role in the school safety program. The Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee shall have the following responsibilities:

- 1. Establish and maintain relationships with the local Fire and Emergency Services Department and Emergency Management Department.
- 2. Work with the faculty in determining the nature and timing of the Department's participation in the school program.
- 3. Coordinate and supervise planned activities.

As necessary or appropriate administrators shall seek the advice and cooperation of the Town Fire Marshal and Fire and Emergency Services Department in:

- 1. Planning and conduct of fire drills.
- 2. Fire prevention education.
- 3. First aid, especially in fire related incidents.
- 4. Conforming to state and local fire codes.
