Publications

Student publications are important elements of the instructional program and contribute directly to the accomplishment of the school's goals. The board of education shall encourage the development of school newspapers, annual, and magazines.

Freedom of speech and of expression in student publications as guaranteed by the First Amendment is to be observed scrupulously by the administration, faculty and students.
