Instructional Resources and Textbooks

The Board of Education shall endeavor to assist teachers and students in accomplishing the educational goals of the district by providing the necessary supporting resources and services within the limits of fiscal constraints. Such resources and services may include, but are not limited to, audiovisual media and print materials, school library media centers, consultant and resource teachers, as well as individual and remedial support services. The Superintendent or his/her designees shall have the authority to select those instructional resources including textbooks and services in order to meet the educational objectives of the District.
