Home Schooling

Eligibility for School Activities & Offerings

The Scotland Board of Education believes that formal education in the public schools is highly beneficial both for the child and the society, but it also recognizes the right of parents to fulfill their obligation to ensure an education of their children by schooling them at home. The Board instructs the school administration to work cooperatively with home schooling parents.

Home schooling is viewed by the Scotland Board of Education as full time and therefore home schooled students are not eligible for school offerings or activities.

Participation in Scotland Community school activities and offerings shall be restricted to full time students enrolled at Scotland Elementary School.
