Instruction

Use of Commercially Produced Video Recordings/DVDs

Digital media will be selected and assigned to give support directly to instructional learning objectives contained within the Board approved curriculum.

Digital media, when used, shall be selected for their direct relevance to the instructional program. General selection criteria should include quality of the overall worth and its individual parts, fair and accurate representation of the facts, the reputation and significance of the writer, director, and/or performer.

Digital media shall not be used for recreation or entertainment use. If used for planned, instructional purposes, it must be approved by the school principal.
