Orientation of Board Members

Experienced Board members and the administrative staff shall assist each new member-elect to understand the Board functions, policies, procedures and the operation of the school system through the following methods:

- 1. New members shall be given selected materials on the functions, responsibilities and authorities of the Board, school district and the Superintendent of Schools;
- 2. New members shall be invited to attend Board meetings and to participate in discussions;
- 3. New members shall be invited to meet with the Superintendent, Principal, and other administrative personnel to discuss their duties and responsibilities and be provided a tour of the school building; continuing Board members shall be notified of and invited to such meetings;
- 4. New members shall be provided with a copy of Board policies and bylaws, Superintendent's administrative regulations and pertinent materials developed by the Connecticut Association of Boards of Education (CABE);
- 5. New members shall be encouraged to attend new member workshops approved by the Board of Education.
