Code of Conduct on Data Use

As a guide to the appropriate use of data in the decision-making process, Board members shall:

- 1. Request data as a Board, not as an individual, unless the information is readily available and will not redirect staff time.
- 2. Avoid using the Board position and the information data supplies as a result of Board membership, for personal gain.
- 3. Respect the confidentiality of privileged information.
- 4. Request information and data gathered by District staff that helps the Board members make better-informed decisions about policies affecting student achievement district-wide.
- 5. Use data to represent all of the Board member's constituents honestly and equally and refuse to surrender the Board member's responsibilities to special interest or partisan political groups.
- 6. Recognize that decisions can be made only by a majority vote at a Board meeting after everyone on the Board has had adequate time to review all the data and information.
- 7. Abide by majority decisions of the Board, while retaining the right to seek changes through ethical and constructive channels.
